MENTORSHIP PROGRAMME VIMSAR STANDARD OPERATING PRCEDURE Version 2016-1.0



Vision

Mentoring is to help, support and encourage the students to manage their learning effectively so as to maximize their performance and ultimately become the medical graduate with five attributes as envisioned by VSS Institute of Medical Sciences and Research. It will help to nurture, motivate and empower the learner to build up his capability and self-reliance so that he/she performs to his/her maximum potential through the positive personal partnership relationship. A Mentorship Program is being launched for the Undergraduate Medical Students of our Institution with effect from the Academic Session 2016 – 17.

The Mentees

All the Undergraduate Medical Students across from first to ninth -all Five Semesters shall be the mentees.

The Mentors

Mentors shall be including the faculty as well as peers and seniors. The select group shall include,

- 1. Selected Faculties of this Institution.
- 2. Selected Postgraduate Students
- 3. Selected Interns

The Mentoring Groups

The mentees and mentors shall be organised into structured clusteres to be called Mentor-Mentee Groups. About 750 Undergraduate Students in this Institution shall be included in as many as **50 Mentorship Groups** each **Mentor- Mentee Group**[MMG] shall be consisting of 3 Mentors and 15 Mentees. The moment the MBBS admission capacity turns 250 each MMG shall be including 5 mentees .Composition of each MMG shall be as follows.

- 1. Three UG students from each batch i.e. semester batches- 1/2,3-4,4-5,6-7 and 8-9 totalling to 15 Mentees[Mentee]
- 2. One nominated Intern[Junior mentor]
- 3. One nominated PG student preferably from first Year[Senior Mentor]
- 4. One nominated faculty [Chief Mentor]

The Duties Of A Mentor :

The Do's

- The Mentor shall listen carefully to the problems and doubts of the Mentee, understand him and help him to relieve his stress through a positive, humorous, hand-holding and caring attitude.
- 2. The Mentor shall motivate him to learn in a relaxed atmosphere, and help him develop his **Self-Confidence** & **Self-Reliance**.
- 3. The Mentor shall put **Ethical Values** into the budding professional.
- 4. The Mentor shall help the Mentee to **Identify** his own **Issues** as well as his **Goals** and help him find out his **own ways** to resolve them and achieve them, respectively.
- 5. He should provide Honest & Constructive Criticism.
- 6. The Mentor shall be a**vailable** to the Mentee at any time that is fixed for a meeting, at any time when he needs him urgently.
- 7. The Mentor may visit the hostel rooms of the Mentee and be in touch.
- 8. He shall be in touch with the **Parents** of the Mentee periodically.
- 9. The Mentor shall encourage **Extracurricular Activities** of the Mentees.
- 10. The Mentor shall keep all facts of the Mentee **confidential** and foster trust of the Mentee on him.
- 11. The Mentor shall practice what he preaches and should try to be a **Role Model** for the Mentee.
- 12. The Mentor shall **desist from** displaying **favoritism** to his Mentees during the academic activities in the college.
- 13. The Mentor shall make himself responsible for the **holistic growth** of the Mentee.
- 14. The Mentor shall ensure that each Mentee maintain a **Mentee Logbook/Mentoring Diary** to enter details of mentoring activities and progress steps of the concerned Mentee across the professional course in the institute. It shall be signed by the Chief Mentor periodically.
- 15. The Chief Mentor should give a **Bimonthly Report** to the Dean and Principal of the Mentoring Meetings and Interactions as per standard format issued.

The Don'ts

- 1. He should **not do** problem-solving for them, but help him to find out answers to his own problems, by himself.
- 2. He should **not force** the Mentee to do things as the way he did, but respect different ways of working.

The Duties Of A Mentee

The Do's

- A Mentee shall clearly understand the Purpose of the relationship, i.e. for Academic Growth / Career Guidance / Personal Support.
- 2. A Mentee shall aim to identify and explore his **own strength and weakness** under guidance and support and not expect the Mentor to do it for him.
- 3. A Mentee shall be willing to **Exploit his Self-Potential** to the maximum under his Mentor's supervision and Strive to achieve steady progress and satisfaction at different levels like Academic, Career and Personal.
- 4. A Mentee shall Be **committed** to the relationship andbe reliable.
- 5. A Mentee shall Identify the **Meeting Hours and its Frequency** as per his need.
- 6. A Mentee shall Follow his Mentor's Suggestions.

The Don'ts

- 1. A Mentee shall not be **Afraid** to Ask Questions.
- 2. A Mentee shall not **React to Criticisms** but Accept Responsibilities and Posiive feedback Gracefully.

Roll Out & Implementation:

- 1. The **Mentorship Program** will run in the Institution as per the **SOP** prepared.
- 2. Medical Education Technology Unit [METU, VIMSAR] shall be the Nodal Agency for the Programme.
- 3. The Education Section [UG Education Clerk] shall be offering the office assistance.
- 4. Fifty **Mentee–Mentor–Groups** will be notified to be constituted by the Dean and Principal.
- 5. A Sensitization Session for Mentors shall be organized on the concept, the programme and its delivery.
- 6. A Sensitization Session for Students shall also be organized for students in batches as well.
- 7. MMG Meets shall be called by the Chief Mentor at leat once a month at a sutable time and venue.
- 8. Special Meets may also be arranged on Mentee driven basis .
- 9. **A Group Leader and a Rapporteur** shall be nominated in the MMG in rotaion by the Chief Mentor.
- 10. Each Mentee shall be maintaining **one Mentoring Dairy** to be countersigned by Chief Mentor periodically and at each Meet.
- 11. **Monthly Reports** on the Mentorship Meetings will be deposited to the Dean and Principal by the by the Chief Mentor at the Education Section.
- 12. Any MMG may be assigned **Specific Tasks** by the Dean and Principal as per need basis to address a problem or situation.
- 13. **A Mentors Meet** shall be held in every quarter of the academic session to discuss and sort out common issues towards evolution of the programme.
- 14. **Verbal feedback and interactions** shall be always encouraged from form any Mentee or Mentor at any time apart from occasions of formal notified Meets.
- 15. Amendments into the SOP of the Programme may be ordered by the Dean and Principal from time to time.
